

The Sevenfold Voice of the Lord

The **Seven fold Voice** of the **God of Glory** or Glorious God; the same **King of Glory** who *enters* when our heads (our consciousness or *everlasting doors* - the eyes, ears and mouth gates or gates of the mind which transcend the death experience having roots in the spiritual body) are *lifted up*, or our consciousness raised like after a jolt of strong coffee early one groggy morning. [Psalm 24:7-10](#)

The selfsame **Lord of strength** or **strong Lord**; the **conquering Lion Lord** who rides a white horse; from out whose mouth proceeds shiny cutting steel, the selfsame general of the armies of heaven [Rev 19:11- 16](#) who storms the gates of hell; and against whose might those gates cannot prevail. [Matthew 16:18](#) but do yield and crumble, allowing Him entrance and access to plunder and pillage, releasing its prisoners [Ephesians 4:8-10](#) and usher in their Jubilee. [Luke 4:18](#)

He is the **King of Glory**, unto whom belongs all power, **information**/knowledge, mobility/transportation, and wealth, [Rev 5:12](#) / [Math 28:18](#) who is faithful and true. [Rev 19:11](#) Amen. :-

He is the shining superstar The Word of God. The Lion Conqueror, The Man of War. This is why and how David was a man after God's own heart. Yes because he was a good shepherd, but more so, because he was a man of war.

War is about conquest. The seizure of enemy territory. The plundering of alien cities. The pillaging of foreign treasuries, the heist of assets, the liberation of the enemy's prisoners of war and their recruitment in your swelling murderous forces. David was most at home when bathing in blood. So is our God – a war Lord.

These are graphic images....and necessary to understand to engage in SP. The kingdom of heaven is all about violence. But a violence that looks quite opposite to the fleshly slaughter that we are accustomed with our callous war crimes, our bombs, our bullets, our missiles.

But equal force is applied....similar violence is invoked, similar attitudes and dispositions are required; but directed inwards, not outwards. The flesh being slaughtered is our own. The blood being spilled is our life force being emptied at the altar of obedience. The life being slain is our own. The "Not my will but thine be done" drama....with the accompanying blood sweat and tears of the inner struggle – the inner warfare being waged for the Eternal Word to emerge victorious from our dead carcasses. The Holy vulture hovering over the dead carcasses of those putting their lives on the line for the kingdom to be manifested. This the sign of the Lord's Presence. His Parousia.

The armies being subdued are the unruly forces and thoughts within our own soul. The territory being seized is the ground beneath our own feet. Our earth. Our territory. Our circumstances. Our cities. And the war here? The Glorious Lord Himself. Amen.

We have misconstrued much..... and given birth to wind. Stinking wind. This warfare is also metaphorized as childbirth. Again a violent, bloody, messy business. Anytime spirit is incarnating, there will be bloody confusion. Flesh and spirit are volatile!

The outcome of both spiritual warfare and spiritual birth is the same – Victory! Both warfare and labor characterize intercessory prayer / Synchronizing Prayer (SP) and represent the process that ensues from the moment of **asking** to the point of **receiving**. SP starts when

an individual / group / nation first starts to **seek** and continues till they **find**. SP is initiated by the first **knock** and only concludes when **the door is opened**.

This is a journey of gestation. This is a war mission of conquest. It is measured not by time but by words. Words travelling up and down the prayer ladder in the form of angels. Light beings. The Word of God descending and the words of man ascending, till perfect synchronicity is achieved. The Word of God riding from stronghold city to stronghold city plundering, pillaging and conquering till every foe is vanquished and Christ is Lord indeed.

The only obstacle to prayer victory is us. God has already given all He will give. The struggle is for us to receive. Hence the sword. Both the ascending word and the descending word Typify the struggle of man...not with God, but with his own identity, changed only when perfect synchronicity is arrived at in conversation. Coherent consciousness. Fusion of the mind of man with the mind of Christ.

The principalities and powers we rightly externalize and personalize, are in reality our own thought shadows. They have no reality apart from the reality we give them. No power apart from the power ceded them through our asynchronous habits and attitudes. We are God's image on the earth. There is no other besides Him.

For the earth is the Lord's and ALL them that dwell therein. He founded it upon the seas. And established it upon the floods. But who shall go up the hill is the question? Who will achieve his highest potential (Unity with God) (Identity in and with God) He that hath clean hands and a pure heart. This is the generation of Jacob. The man who wrestled with God and won. Amen.

Psalm 29

³ *the God of glory **thundereth**:*

1. The Voice of the Lord **is expansive.**

It **thunders** - reverberates /echoes through space time. It comes in waves. Repetitions. It thunders out his lightning. (Einstein saw one vision of himself riding a rainbow. (the lightning) It was years of intellectual articulation that thundered out the general theory of relativity.) Whatever God says comes in waves.

*the LORD is **upon many waters.***

2. The Voice of the Lord **is exponential.**

It is the **sound of many waters**. Reverberating through many people. Circumstances. Situations, Seasons and Ages - Waves. Cycles. Repetitions. The nature of the prophetic is cyclical. *Many* reverberations. Both of time as well as place. This explains why the Rhema of God is applicable and relevant to so many people in very different situations and how God can speak one word to the angel of a church and every one 'gets it'. Its scope is wide. Not particular - but wavelike.

*The voice of the LORD is **powerful**; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty.*

*⁵The voice of the LORD **breaketh** the cedars; yea, the LORD breaketh the cedars of Lebanon. ⁶He maketh them also to skip like a calf; Lebanon and Sirion like a young unicorn.*

3. The Voice of the Lord is **explosive**.

The awesomely explosive voice of the Lord **breaks** pride. Breaks the stouthearted. Breaks the confidence of kings. Breaks the strength of the mighty. Brings down high towers. Amen. It **dislodges**. Uproots. Makes that which was established to become unstable. This is explosive energy. A bomb blast that dislodges great trees. God's voice has explosive impact. God's voice is potentially very dangerous. Tremendously powerful.

*⁷The voice of the LORD **divideth** the flames of fire.*

4. The Voice of the Lord is **excisive**.

It **divides**. It separates. It reveals differences. Utters judgments. Creates distinctions. Cuts. Is sharp and precise. Detailed and pointed leaving no refuge of lies. Provokes enmity. Breaks unions.

*⁸The voice of the LORD **shaketh the wilderness**; the LORD shaketh the wilderness of Kadesh.*

5. The Voice of the Lord is **investigative**.

It **shakes** - It tries foundations. Like an earthquake. Like shaking a tree till its fruit falls off, Is relentless and unyielding. Is extremely destabilizing.

*⁹The voice of the LORD **maketh the hinds to calve**,*

6. The Voice of the Lord is **creative**.

It brings to birth. Causes new conceptions to emerge. Brings about newness and change.

and discovereth the forests...

7. And the Voice of the Lord is **revelatory**.

It strips veneers, searches out and discovers what was in hiding, disembowels, lays bare, exposes the innards. [Judges 3 20-23](#)
